- 15h30 Visit the World Heritage Wine Museum of Tokaj**
The Wine Museum offers an interactive museography of the vitivinicul-ture of Tokaj Wine Region. The museum presents other World Heri-tage Wine Regions and gives educational activities. After visiting the Museum, *György Posta*, the Mayor of Tokaj presents touristic plans of the town by a small walk in the city center.

- 16h45 Travel to Bodrogkeresztúr – Panoramic Landscape of the Wine Region**

- 17h30 Guided tour and Wine tasting at Szepsy Vineyard in Mád**
World Class Wine tasting. The *Szepsy family* started winegrowing in Tokaj-Hegyalja already by the end of the 16th century. *István Szepsy* is one of the most important Hungarian winemaker. He fo-cuses on radical limitation of harvest. Not only the Aszú berries but the berries for the base wine are manually selected.

- 20h Dinner at the Gusteau Grill with the members of Tokaj Wine Region Development Council**

Tuesday, October 18th 2016

- 9h00 Guided tour at the Szirmay-Waldbott Castle**
During the tour we are visiting the Event Centre for Heritage Tour-ism and Culture in the Szirmay-Waldbott Castle, Tolcsva. Devel-oping the mansion into a tourist attraction is based on three pillars: creating a visitor centre with focus on heritage, establishing community areas and revitalization of the park.
- 10h20 Visit to World Heritage properties: Köporosi and Gombos-hegyi Cellars in Hercegkút**
The village of Hercegkút was established in 1748-49 on a logged land by Swabian settlers. The World Heritage properties are excep-tional in the village of the tiered wine cellar rows. The wine cellars comprises more than eighty cellars, they are dugged into the hill-sides, are running one above the other at both locations. During our visit we meet *József Rák*, the Mayor of Hercegkút.
- 12h00 Lunch in Hercegkút**
Swabian lunch called “Tunki”
- 14h00 Guided tour and wine tasting at Patricius Winery**
Presentation of the wine variety. A decisive winery of the Tokaj Wine Region are producing delicate taste dry and sweet wine together with unforgettable Aszú wines. The winery produces its internation-ally acknowledged wines on 85 hectares by strong yield limitation, gravitational process and careful wine making. If the weather is sunny, you can enjoy the wonderful panoramic view from the ter-race overlooking the Tokaj-Hill and the floodplain of Bodrog River.
